Summary of Last Week's (4/8) Sermon

Three Tenses of Salvation

Ephesians 2:4, 5

Every language has ways to convey time: The Past, Present and Future. Ephesians chapter two describes our past, present and future in Christ. **1. The Past Tense. You Were Dead** (Ephesians 2:1, 2) This refers to "all of us"! We were slaves to the world and the flesh, under Satan's influence. **You Were Deserving of Punishment** (Ephesians 2:3). **You Were Separated from God.** (Ephesians 2:11, 12) Everyone has rebelled against God. In our natural state we cannot respond to God. We were separated from God -- spiritually dead! **BUT God Made Us Alive** (Ephesians 2:4-6) This is why we celebrate Easter! Jesus lives and through Him we have live! **We Have Been Saved** (Ephesians 2:8, 9; John 5:24) **You Have Been Brought Near** (Ephesians 2:13) **2. The Present Tense.** ¹³ **But now** in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. **He Is Our Peace** (Ephesians 2:14) **We Have Access To The Father** (Ephesians 2:18) **We Are Members of God's Household** (Ephesians 2:19) **We Are Being Built to Be God's Dwelling** (Ephesians 2:21, 22) **2. The Future Tense. In the Coming Ages He Will Show His Love** (Ephesians 2:7) The Past is death. Don't let it be your future. Receive life through Christ!! We Have Passed From Death to Life! We Now Live a New Life in Christ! We Will Enjoy his Love for Eternity!
